

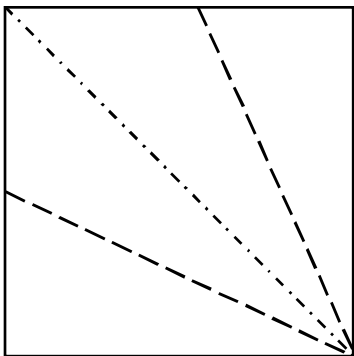

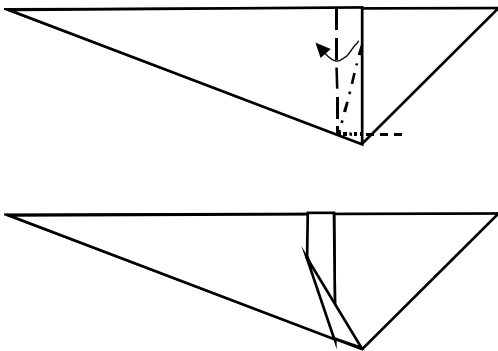
Developed in Jan 04 by Ching-Yu Hung. This is a simplified version of a Borg from a translated origami book which I'm still trying to track down the original author.

Repeat on the other side. Open it up and work from the inside.

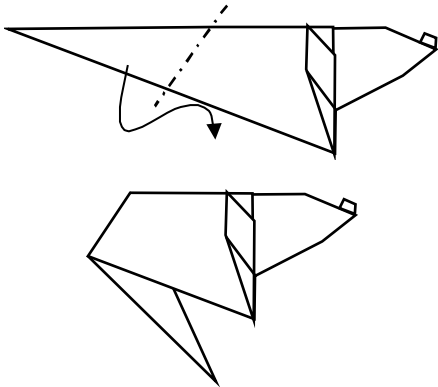

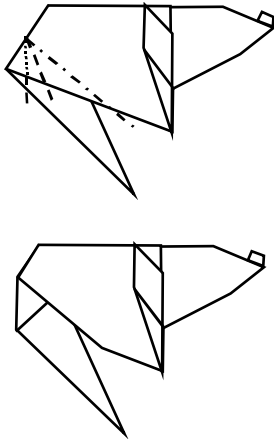
Repeat on the other side symmetrically. Close the design. Fold the nose with two inside reverse folds and then tuck in the tip. Do an inside reverse fold on each ear to sharpen it.



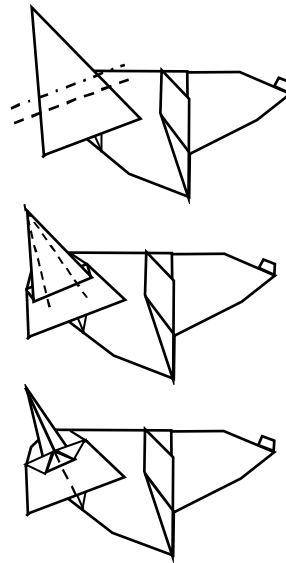
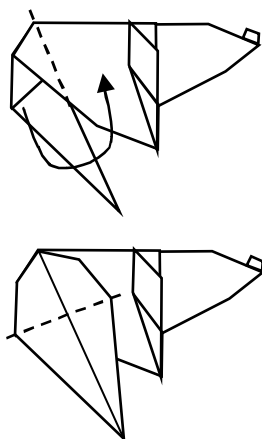

Do an inside reverse fold on the rear half of body.

Fold as shown on both sides to form the two rear legs.

Open up the rear to work on the tail. Sharpen the tail as shown and close the rear.

Do an inside reverse fold to tuck in the excess between the rear legs. Curl the tail, shape the body more 3-D like, and you're done.
